





J.B. Rivard sent me an excerpt of his newest article that appeared in the April issue of The American Legion Magazine, (circulation, 1.7M).

"Remembering the Mushroom Clouds," is illustrated and accompanied by sidebars. It observes the 60th anniversary of the last explosions of nuclear weapons in the atmosphere during Operation Dominic in 1962.

In the era of 2022, this may seem as of little significance. But during the Cold War, it demonstrated that the U.S. was not to be intimidated. Dominic was ordered by President John Kennedy in 1961 as response to the USSR's breaking of the previous ban on nuclear testing. It was a demonstration that the U.S. would do what was necessary in defense of western values.

I, along with about 20,000 others, participated. I was part of the Safety Radar crew that monitored the B-52 airdrop phase of the tests from a Pacific Island 1500 miles south of Hawaii. Christmas, now known as Kiritmati, is the largest coral atoll in the world, about 32 miles wide, max.

The article covers the airdrops by B-52 aircraft, which were tracked, by the Sandia Corp. radar, and includes all 24 detonations of the series, including hydrogen bombs.

I feel as though I should address a concern that I've been made aware concerning the Newsletter. There are often times when I am questioned as to why the newsletter isn't the same as when John Moore produced it or how they wished it were still the same way. The fact is, things change. Whether it be for the better or worse, things change. People change, situations change, interests change....there's no stopping change.

I print what the Mishawaka Education Foundation (MEF) is doing for the schools and in the community so that you can have the opportunity to go to the events that benefit the school district.

The Athletic Department no longer prints the pocket sports calendars that so many of you relied on, I print that so that you can still see when the games are without having to look online. Most of the same information is still being reported, it's just in a different format. Again, if there is something you would like to me to publish, feel free to call, email or mail me your information. I hope this helps answers some of the concerns that I'm hearing about.


