

Hidden History of Mishawaka: New Book Celebrates Mishawaka History

Books about Mishawaka's history do not come along often, so when a new title is published, it is a historic event in its own right.

Mishawaka's Historian Laureate and 1986 M.H.S. graduate Peter J. De Kever has written *Hidden History of Mishawaka*, available now from Arcadia Publishing and The History Press.

The 160-page paperback includes 10 essays on forgotten stories of people and events that shaped the city and

even influenced the nation. They include the life of first mayor Manuel Fisher, Vice President Charles Fairbanks's visit in 1908, the city's exciting Independence Day celebration in 1909 that saw the dedication of Hotel Mishawaka, the story behind an iconic photo of Mishawaka recruits who served in World War I, the 1926-27 Mishawaka High basketball team that reached the state finals, the construction and dedication of the school's W.P.A. football stadium, the Cavemen's 20 greatest home football victories, Ball-Band's vital role in the Doolittle Raid during World War II, Richard Caleal and the automotive design that saved Ford Motor Company, and the Talos missile, which brought Mishawaka's vengeance to the skies of North Vietnam.

The book is richly illustrated with over 50 historic and contemporary photos, many not published in decades.

Hidden History of Mishawaka retails for \$21.99 and is available through arcadiapublishing.com and other online book retailers, or call Arcadia Publishing at (888) 313-2665.


