
MHS Alumni Newsletter

John C. Moore, 90, of Mishawaka passed away on April 11, 2021. Born in South Bend on November 4, 1930 to the late John and Marie (Bauerlein) Moore, the family settled in Mishawaka where John lived all of his life.

John was a man of the people. Wherever he went, he made friends or met someone to have a conversation with. He devoted much of his time and energy to his beloved Mishawaka, where in recent years he enjoyed sharing memories of his childhood, adolescent adventures, and many misdeeds over drives along Lincoln Way from the East End.


John was a star athlete in his youth, which inspired a lifelong love of sports. He attended the University of Arizona on an athletic scholarship before being drafted into the Army in 1950. In 1951, while stationed in Aberdeen, Maryland, he married his high school sweetheart Jean Anne Rodgers.

After basic training, John shipped to Korea where he proudly served his country for 18 months. His first daughter, Rebecca, was born in 1952 during his service. A second daughter, Kathryn, followed in 1955.

After returning home from the war, John had a successful career as a sales manager. He participated in fast pitch softball for many years and later led the Wagner Steel team to a state championship.

John was a long-suffering Cubs fan and proud New York Yankees fan. He and Jean Anne were Notre Dame ticket holders for thirty years and spent many wonderful Saturday afternoons tailgating with good friends and family.

Passionate supporters of the Special Olympics of St. Joseph County, for nearly 20 years John and Jean Anne could be found at track meets as timers or judges at local, regional, and state meets. John later served on the Board of Directors. He began donating blood in the late 1940s and remained a passionate blood and platelet donor for the rest of his life.

John was a member of the BK Club, the DeAmici's Club, DeLorito Club, and Club 15. He was a founding member and director of the Mishawaka High School Alumni Association, which grew from 13 members to over 3,000 members in all 50 states and seven foreign countries under his leadership. John was inducted into the Mishawaka High School Athletic Hall of Fame and was awarded the first Mishawaka Education Foundation Growing the Future Award in 2005.

In 2013, John and Jean Anne moved to the Sanctuary at St. Paul's in South Bend, where they participated in the bell choir, joined the welcoming committee, played bridge and euchre, and visited with old and new friends. John is survived by his daughter, Rebecca M. Strickland and son-in-law Kevin J. McDevitt. Also surviving are five grandchildren: Briana Jean (McDevitt) Wojciechowski and her husband James, Elizabeth Marie Strickland and her husband Cristiano Vendrame, Cara Rose (McDevitt) Murphy and her husband Brian, Shannon Moore McDevitt, and Connor Daniel McDevitt. He was a proud great-grandfather of four. John is preceded in death by his wife Jean Anne, daughter Kathryn A. McDevitt, son-in-law Terry K. Strickland and sister, Rosemarie Lindahl.




Local News
