## SECOND SEMESTER PLAN

(BEGINNING JANUARY 4, 2021)

While School City of Mishawaka (SCM) has endeavored to provide robust virtual learning experiences for our students, nothing replaces the experience students receive when they are in a classroom with their teachers and peers. Having students out of school creates a challenge for some of our families that rely on SCM to not only provide an education for their children, but to safely care for their children so they can pursue their livelihoods for their families.

The Indiana State Department of Health released metrics for Indiana schools that recommend elementary schools to be in-person and middle and high schools to be in a hybrid learning environment for the current level for St. Joseph County. Dr. Fox of the St. Joseph County Department of Health is supportive of these recommendations and the SCM Roadmap to Reopening: Second Semester Plan.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

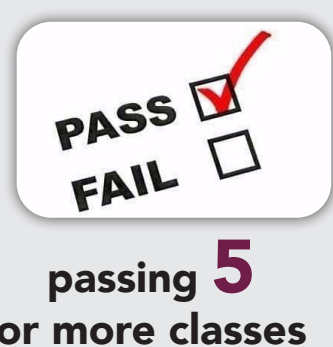
- All virtual students will have a blend of live virtual instruction and self-directed learning.
- Core classes will utilize live virtual instruction when students are not in person.
- Elective classes will utilize a blend of live virtual instruction and self-directed learning.
- Students who remain 100% virtual will have a blend of live virtual instruction and self-directed learning.

#### \*NOTE

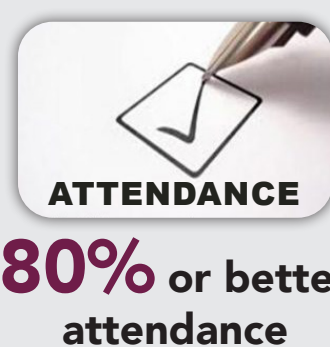
Students who are currently virtual and do not meet SCM virtual learning success criteria will be issued an academic probation letter on November 19, 2020. If the student does not meet the requirements outlined in the letter by December 18, 2020, the student will return to in-person learning on January 4, 2020 unless they are able to produce medically fragile documentation for self or household members by December 30, 2020.

In the 3rd term, students need to be:

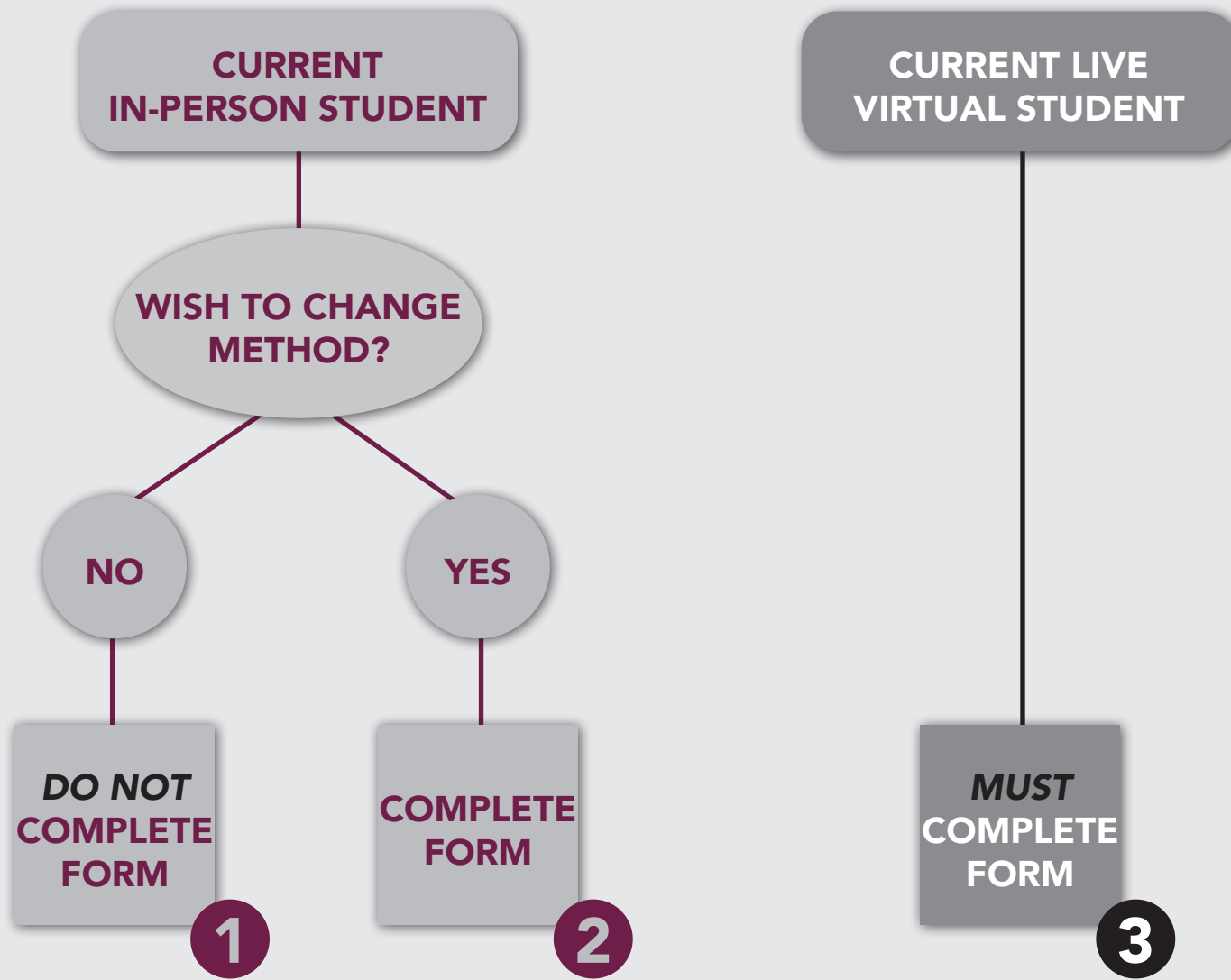

### STUDENT LEARNING OPTION SELECTION PROCESS

#### WHO SHOULD COMPLETE THE COMMITMENT FORM



- 1** If you are a **CURRENT IN-PERSON** student and wish to **CONTINUE IN-PERSON** for the second semester, no action is required at this time.
  - However, no action on behalf of in-person students is a recommitment to in-person learning for the second semester.
- 2** If you are a **CURRENT IN-PERSON** student and wish to **MOVE TO VIRTUAL LEARNING** for the second semester, parents/guardians must fill out a commitment form for each child making a virtual learning selection.

- 3** If you are a **CURRENT VIRTUAL** student, parents/guardians **MUST** fill out a commitment form for each child making a selection of in-person instruction or live virtual learning.
