#### 5 Star MHS Alumni.....

When the ball stops bouncing, you'll have to look a long time to find someone to match the career of **Sharon** Versyp....MHS class of 1984. The 5'9" point guard led the Lady Cavemen to a 24-1 record her senior year and was named Miss Indiana of Indiana in 1984. She led her Indiana All-Stars to two victories over the Kentucky All-Stars. **Sharon** was an outstanding volleyball player also, as she led her team to two state finals, winning the championship in 1983. She is a member of the Mishawaka Hall of Fame.

After her graduation from MHS, Sharon enrolled at Purdue Universityy where she became a starter all four years for the Boilermakers. She was named to the All Big Ten team in 1988 as well as Athlete of the Year.

Her coaching career began in 1986-87 as an assistant coach at the University of Louisville for three seasons. She then became head coach at Maine University for five years. Next stop was at Indiana University for one year before she accepted the head coaching job at her alma mater, Purdue University in 2006. After 11 years at Purdue, her record is 237-133 (.641), nine of those years, she also had her teams in the NCAA Tournament 9 times. She has directed her Boilermaker team to four Big Ten Tournament championships.

On March 6, 2017, Sharon announced that she had been diagnosed with a form of breast cancer. A statement from Purdue said she is still discussing treatment options with her doctor, and is very encouraged by the prognosis.

Sharon said, "I feel incredibly blessed to have caught this in its earliest stage and cannot not stress enough the importance of regular screening. With the support group around me, from my family, my staff and our Purdue family, I know I'll beat this and come back stronger.'


