#### One Of Mishawaka's Finest Passes On...



# A MHS Icon Passes Away..... Justin E. "Barney" Arata....Class of 1939

Justin "Barney" Arata. 96 years old grew up on the Northside of Mishawaka and attended St. Monica's Elementary School before enrolling in Mishawaka High School where he lettered in football. After graduation he completed his undergraduate work at Indiana University in Bloomington, IN. He then entered Indiana University School of Medicine Where he was class president and earned the Alpha Omega Alpha scholastic award.

After completing medical school, **Justin** entered the U.S. Navy and served in WW II where he participated in the atomic bomb tests at Bikini in 1946. After his discharge as a Lieutenant, junior grade he returned to Ft. Wayne where he completed 15 months of post graduate work at St. Joseph Hospital.

He then moved to Gregory, South Dakota for nine months in general practice; this was followed up with a surgical grant to Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN. Along came the Korean War and he was called back to serve his country again. Upon his discharge, **Justin** returned to private surgical practice in 1954 where he continued his practice until his retirement in 1991.

**Dr. Justin Arata's** awards, accomplishments and humanitarian deeds would fill this entire page.

Van Gates was the honored guest at the recent MEF 2017 Growing The Future Dinner/Auction. A 1942 graduate of MHS has been a loyal and very generous member of the MHS Alumni. Van and his wife Jean, have raised a beautiful family who operate the Gates Automotive Company, now reside in South Bend with homes in Marco Island, FL and enjoy their summers at their home on Lake Michigan.

A few years ago, Van authored a book, "Looking In <u>The Rear View Mirror</u>" which described how his father, L.O. Gates, started the Chevrolet dealership in Mishawaka and how it progressed through the years to be what it is today.

#### A MHS Icon Passes Away..... Bruce Chamberlin.....Class of 1945

**Bruce** grew up within a stones throw of the high school on Wenger Street with his nine brothers and sisters. After his graduation from MHS, he received his Bachelors degree from Indiana University in Bloomington, IN, and a Masters degree from Notre Dame . He served his country in the U.S. Navy during WW II and then was called up again during the Korean conflict.

**Bruce** taught English and Speech at high school for 33 years (1954-1987) During this time, he initiated a TV Productions program. It is estimated that **Bruce** touched the lives of over **10,000** MHS students during his career. He also taught public speaking for 20 years at IUSB.

He married Carol Vanderbosch in 1951 and together they raised 6 children. A member of St. Monica's Church, Bruce always found time to raise thousands of dollars for his favorite charity, Hospice. He was a novice ventriloquist and loved the annual Memorial Day parade in Mishawaka where he could show off his "Alexander T. Redwood." He and Carol enjoyed walking across Mishawaka Avenue from their home in the summer time to listen to the Monday concerts at Battell Park.

**Bruce** was a long time loyal member of the MHS Alumni and will be missed by many.
